AJC Reports:

School Districts Represented by Brock Clay Paid the Least Amount in Legal Fees—By Far!

The Atlanta Journal-Constitution conducted a study of legal fees paid by large metro Atlanta school districts. The two districts represented by Brock Clay (**Fulton and Cobb**) spent less than their counterparts, by far. Below is a comparison of the total fees spent for the year ending June 30, 2010 by school districts of over 50,000 in student enrollment.

-DeKalb	\$5.79 million
-Atlanta	\$2.7 million
-Gwinnett	\$1.89 million (which does not include 5 other contracted attorneys)
-Fulton	\$1.8 million
-Cobb	\$1.75 million
