Mobile Unit Visits the Office of Brock Clay Calhoun & Rogers to Help Provide Lifesaving Blood in Time of Need



For individuals in need of transfusions there is no substitute for blood; and volunteer giving is the main source to keep our community supplied. On October 23, 2009 employees of Brock Clay, led by Blood Drive Volunteer Chairperson Virginia Wheeler, gave their time to help provide the “gift of life”

Throughout the day, employees and volunteers entered the red, white and blue bus from LifeSouth to begin the process of giving blood. Each individual was checked to assure they were healthy and able to give that day. The process includes checking a potential donor’s temperature, blood pressure, iron level and pulse. As well, the health screening includes a list of questions regarding the individual’s medical history.

Once cleared, the donors were seated and in a quick 7 – 10 minutes, a pint of blood was ready to be sent to a local hospital or health facility. As a reward, Nutter Butters and water were on hand for all donors and upon completion, their arms were adorned with bright neon colored bandaging to show their friends.

All donors and potential donors were given a coffee mug to thank them and to help provide an on-going reminder of the need for blood throughout the year
